

SOPHOMORE HANDS-ON

As an orientation to career/technical education, all Licking County sophomores are invited to participate in C-TEC's Sophomore Hands-On program which is the first week of December each year. Students are given an overview by the Associate School Liaison and current C-TEC Student Leadership Team members before attending the program. Sophomores choose programs within a career cluster to explore while participating in Sophomore Hands-On.

Applications are available to sophomores after this experience. Applications are due to the Career Development Office the first Friday in February each year. Students must meet eligibility requirements to attend a program at C-TEC. These requirements are: a minimum of 9 credits which include two credits in each of the following: math, English, science, social studies plus PE and Health graduation requirements; positive school attendance; satisfactory school discipline; supportive teacher and counselor recommendations. Some C-TEC program eligibility requirements include additional information such as a principal recommendation, student background check, personal interview and GPA consideration.
